

Upcoming Cross-Island Hike Itinerary

The 24th annual Cross-Island Hike will take place on Saturday, June 4, 2016. It will start at the Pecoy Point Preserve in Oak Bluffs on the Sengekontacket Pond, traverse Chappaquiddick Island, and end 21 miles later at South Beach in Edgartown on the Atlantic Ocean. It passes along the following conservation properties (with estimated departure times from checkpoints).
