Job Description:

Shorebird Monitor The successful applicants will be responsible for following established protocols to monitor rare shorebirds on land bank barrier beach properties. The assistant will be under the direct supervision of the land bank ecologist and must work in a professional manner, pay close attention to detail and follow direction well.

Skills needed:

Successful applicants must possess general knowledge and interest in birds and a strong foundation in shorebird identification skills. Prior coursework or equivalent field experience in ornithology is desirable. Ability to identify shorebird by sight and sound are required. Successful applicants must demonstrate good communication skills; ability to work independently; **have own vehicle transportation**; and enjoy the out-of-doors.

Pay:

Salary is +\$13.50 per hour (15-20 hours/week).
